

ANTI-BULLYING

Definition of Bullying:

- INTINIDATING
- THREATENING
- HARMING CONDUCT that is objectively offensive



AND: There is an actual or perceived imbalance of power

AND: The behavior is repeated or forms a pattern

OR

Materially or substantially interferes with a Student's educational opportunities or performance or ability to participate in school functions or activities or receive school benefits, services or privileges.

MORE INFORMATION:

“A student is bullied when he or she is exposed, repeatedly and over time, to negative actions on the part of one or more other students, and he or she has difficulty defending him or herself.”

Bullying can take place in many forms and includes but is not limited to :

- ⇒ Verbal bullying including derogatory comments and bad names
- ⇒ Bulling through social exclusion or isolation
- ⇒ Physical bullying such as hitting , kicking, shoving and spitting
- ⇒ Bullying through lies or false rumors
- ⇒ Having money or other things taken or damaged by persons who bully
- ⇒ Being threatened or being forced to do things by persons who bully
- ⇒ Racial bullying
- ⇒ Sexual bullying
- ⇒ Cyber bullying (via phone or internet)
