Gibbs Patrick, Sr. started a small 10 acre farm in Tift County, Georgia in 1952. Growing sweet potatoes, corn and soybeans, he and his family grew it to the 3,500 + acres of crops today. With extensive packing and cooling facilities, Patrick Farms is one of the nation's leading producers of squash, cucumbers, peppers, greens, cabbage, cantaloupes, eggplant and strawberries.

With its own packing facility and more than 15,000 square foot of cooling space, Patrick Farms create over 200,000 pounds of ice each day to preserve freshness.

Located in Omega, Georgia this Tift County farm lies in the heart of the Sun Belt, offering a tropical climate that provides some of the world's most fertile soil. Patrick Farms has thrived in this region growing from 10 acres to over 3,500 acres of growing fields.

Patrick Farms grows yellow squash, zucchini, cucumbers, cantaloupe, green bell pepper, red & green jalapeno peppers and strawberries. They also grow cabbage, eggplant, turnip, collard, kale and mustard greens.
