PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Student Ambassadors are a small group of students dedicated to the positive promotion of Mary G. Montgomery High School. <u>These students must be in grades 10-12</u>. They will work on a volunteer basis to serve as liaisons between the community and prospective students. Student Ambassadors are visible at many campus events held for prospective students and families and work in conjunction with other groups when necessary. Student Ambassadors have the unique opportunity to develop and receive training in communication, public relations, marketing and interpersonal skills.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Bearing in mind that Student Ambassadors serve as an essential component to MGM High School's Public Relations effort, several responsibilities are placed on the Student Ambassador. The MGM Ambassadors, a member group sponsored by MGM High School Academies, work closely with alumni, school administration and community groups to promote MGM. As official ambassadors of the school, this group is available to assist with event hosting responsibilities. This elite group is trained to host VIP's and is knowledgeable about MGM school history. Ambassadors will mostly be helping during the school day at MGM, but there will be opportunities for events at other schools, at night, and on weekends.

Responsibilities:

- Act as an ambassador from the student body to prospective students and families at above mentioned events
- □ Assist in the recruitment of future Student Ambassadors

Student Ambassador Program Requirements:

To remain an active Academy Student Ambassador you must attend ALL meetings and required events, 1 training session, actively participate in volunteer offerings, and conduct ALL ambassador actions in a professional manner. Failure to do so, results in immediate disqualification of position by the school administration. If chosen as an Academy Student Ambassador, the student will be responsible for a uniform of black pants or black skirt/skort, white button down shirt, and black shoes. The black skirt/skort must be appropriate length. An official blue blazer is on hand for students to put on for events, but not to take home. All blazers must be returned to the Academy office at the end of the event.

***There is a \$25 fee that will go towards the upkeep of the student's blazer. A t-shirt and professional name tag will also be provided for them.

***Students are welcome to buy their own personal blazer through MGM at a cost of \$100.

*Ambassador boot camp- This is a one day training session to acclimate the student to MGM, leadership, and how to conduct events. Required for participation in Academy Ambassador
