School Assignments

Documentation/Information Required for Enrollment

Parents or legal custodians must provide the school the following documents:

- Birth certificate of student
- Picture identification of the parent or legal custodian (DMV Id, Driver's License, Passport)
- Proof of current residency document (power bill, water bill, gas bill)
- Previous school records (if applicable)

Within 30 calendar days of the first day of attendance, each student must show evidence of age-appropriate vaccinations in accordance with G.S. 130A-154b. Furthermore, all students entering a North Carolina public school for the first time, regardless of grade level, must furnish a health assessment pursuant to G.S. 130A-440 within 30 calendar days of enrollment.
