SACC WILL BE CLOSED - Due to the school hybrid plan, SACC will be closed on days the school is closed.

SACC CHANGES

- All children must wear a mask.
- All children's belongings must remain with them at their seat
- There are now desks in cafeteria, no tables, spaced 6 feet apart
- No toys from SACC will be provided for play due to safety guidelines. Please feel free to bring in a shoebox size container with your child's name placed on the outside with a pencil for homework, crayons and other toys to play with. Each container will be locked in the SACC cabinet. You may trade out toys weekly for cleaning. **NOTHING WILL BE SHARED.**
- Weather permitting SACC will be outside on the playground with social distancing. A sign will be posted on the door for pick up.

PARENT/GUARDIAN PICKUP

- During pickup please utilize the multi-purpose room door. The doors remain locked at all times, so please ring the doorbell to the left of the door.
- A staff member will bring the sign out sheet to you while we have your child/children gather their belongings. We will then walk your child/children out to you.
- Please make sure that your SACC Registration is up to date. Please inform all individuals on your pickup list that a valid identification is required in order to release your child. Also, please inform them of these new procedures.

SACC will still provide a snack or you may pack one for your child. After snack children will work on homework for approximately 30 minutes. All unfinished homework will be sent home.

SACC may appear to be quite different this year from previous years, but it's for the safety of the children that are in my care. I still have many plans for fun activities including crafts that the children will be able to showcase on the SACC bulletin board. Movies are always a welcome tradition on Friday and I am open to suggestions. Since the weather is still warm my plan is to have the children outside as much as possible.
