

PSAT/NMSQT for 10th & 11th Graders

October 19, 2016

The **PSAT/NMSQT** measures the critical reading, math and writing skills students need to succeed in college and beyond. It helps schools improve learning and identify students likely to succeed in AP classes. It also helps students: improve their skills, enter scholarship competitions, practice for the SAT, plan for college and careers, and receive information from colleges. **The test takes approximately 3 hours minutes.**

***It is also a qualifying test that 11th grade students must take to enter the National Merit Scholarship Corporation competition.**

****It is highly recommended for any 10th grader to take this test also if he/she is applying to join the PSAT class. Joining the class will be based on test results and other requirements required from the PSAT Teachers.**
