

RISING PK3 CHECKLIST – NEW STUDENTS

Your child will be in PK3 next year—here’s an important checklist to guide you through the process of Enrolling in PK3 at Guardian Catholic:

- To be considered for Admission to Guardian Catholic School, complete the four steps of the **Admissions Process** (take a virtual tour, apply, come for family interview & student screening, enroll). Click here for directions: [Admissions Process](#).
- You will be eligible for [Success By 6 Funding](#)** through the Early Learning Coalition and the United Way which is designed to provide working parents with year-round funding for child care. **Success By 6 funding covers the total cost of:**
 - The academic portion of the school day from 8:00 -11:30 am
 - School day Wraparound Services from 11:30 am to 3:00 pm
 - Before School Extended Day services from 6:45 -7:50 a.m.
 - After School Extended Day services from 3-6 pm on school days
 - The Summer Camp provided on our campus during the summer months following your child’s PK3 and PK4 school years.

After your Admissions process is complete and you have completed Enrollment for next school year, your name will be sent to Tinesha Byrd at the ELC. Within a few weeks, Ms. Byrd will send you a link to the [Success By 6 Application](#). Please complete it as soon as you get it.

- Enroll in Champions** for their After School Program which is provided right here on campus from 3:00-6:00 pm on school days. This service is free to you and is fully funded by Success By 6. The SB6 funding cannot be used at any other after-school location; it must be used for service provided by Champions.

All Success By 6 parents are encouraged to enroll in Champions prior to the start of the school year. Enrollment is a benefit to you in many ways, even if you don’t choose to use daily after school care. When the unexpected circumstance arises that you cannot pick up on time at the end of the school day, your child will smoothly transition to Champions—and you will avoid late school pick up fees. Champions also operates on most days that school dismisses early.

P.S. If you only have a child in PK3 or PK4 next year—and you have no older siblings enrolled in grades K-8 at Guardian—you do NOT need to set up a FACTS account since you will not be making payments to the school.
