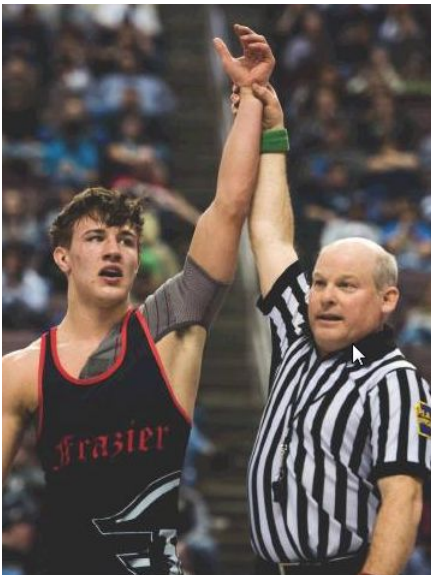
Geary receives President's Volunteer Service Award

PSSA - Pennsylvania System of School Assessment



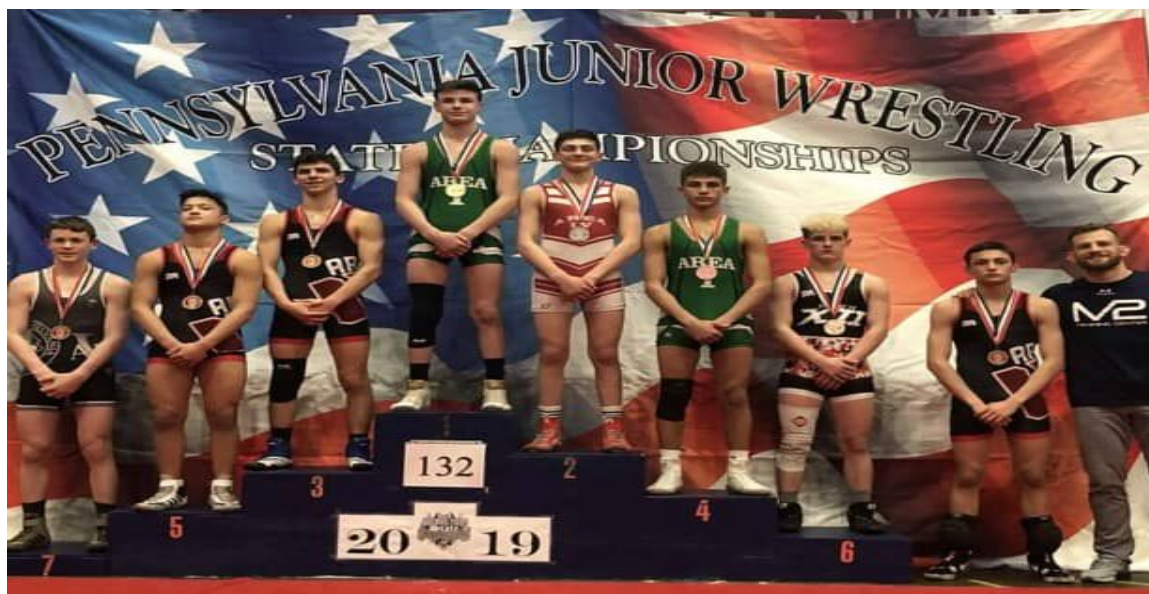

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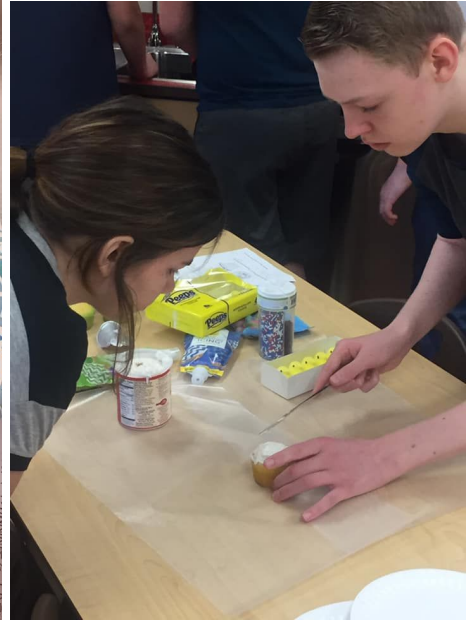
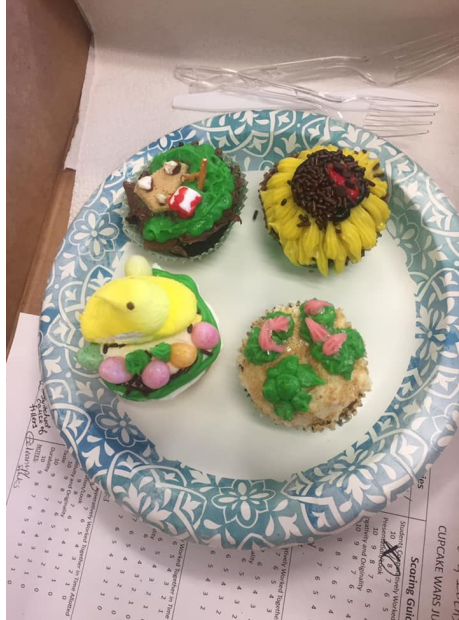
STATE CHAMPION!

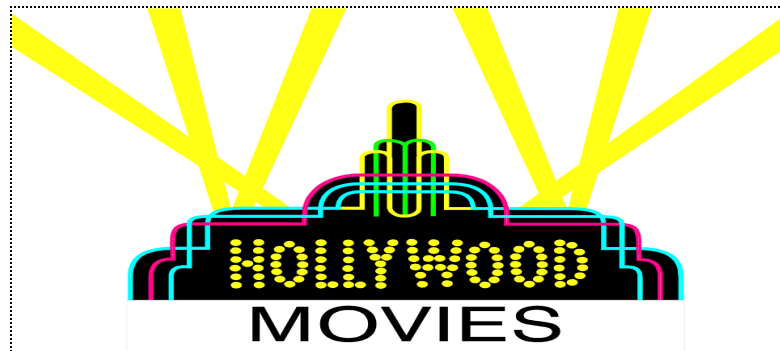
First Grade Community Outreach Effort

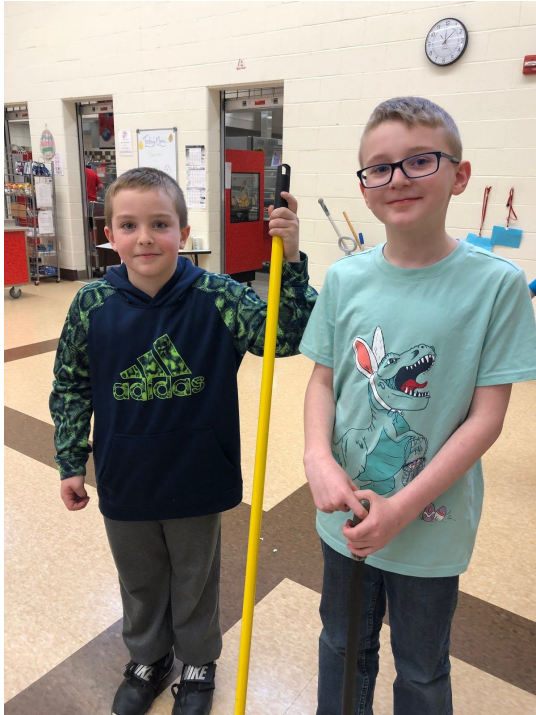
