The regular meeting of the Sumter County Board of Education was held remotely in accordance with COVID-19 guidelines. Vice Chairman Rick Barnes called the meeting to order with the following other members present: Alice Green, Edith Green, Meda Krenson, Jim Reid, Sylvia Roland and Michael Busman.

A motion was made by Ms. Edith Green to adopt the agenda; second by Mr. Reid; motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Krenson made a motion to approve the consent agenda including minutes of the meeting held on May 14, 2020; second by Ms. Alice Green, motion carried unanimously.


NEW BUSINESS


A motion was made by Ms. Edith Green; second by Mrs. Krenson to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Southwest Georgia Community Action Council, Inc. (Head Start Program) and Sumter County Board of Education; motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Alice Green offered a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of The University of Georgia Cooperative Extension and Sumter County Board of Education; second by Mr. Reid; motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Ms. Edith Green; second by Mrs. Roland to increase out-of-district tuition to \$1,800 per year as recommended by the superintendent. Parents will be given the option of paying tuition in full prior to the beginning of the school year or two installments; one at the beginning of the school year and the next payment by the second week in January. The motion carried six in favor; and one opposed (Mr. Barnes).

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:33 p.m. on a motion by Mrs. Roland, second by Ms. Edith Green; motion carried unanimously.
