
## Califon School Reopening Plan

### Goals

- To ensure a safe learning environment for a return to instruction for students and staff.
- To establish protocols for daily disinfection of the school.
- To establish protocols for illness response and reporting to DOH if necessary.
- To establish daily schedules and routines to ensure safety for students and staff.
- To address the impact of closure and reopening on the social emotional learning of students.
- To address communication with families and staff while keeping current with the most up to date information.
- To address policy for both instructional and financial impacts of closure and reopening.

Executive Summary

#### Restart and Recovery Plan for Education

New Jersey Department of Education

The NJ Department of Education has presented guidance related to four key areas:

- Conditions for Learning (10 required components described in this presentation)
- Leadership and Planning (Suggests the creation of a Restart Committee and school-based teams for planning)
- Policy and Funding (Provides considerations to offset fiscal challenges related to the safe reopening of school)
- Continuity of Learning (Suggests a focus on Special Education and Related Services, Technology, Professional Learning, and Curriculum and Instruction)

#### **In-Person Instruction**

#### **Overview:**

- Adjustment of September calendar
- Staggered Arrival/Dismissal times
- Use of Masks & Social Distancing
- Instruction & lunch in classrooms
- Limit "cohort" mixing
- Increased sanitization

#### Key considerations:

- 1. Protects to the greatest degree possible the health and well-being of students and staff.
- 2. Provides instructional consistency and sound practice.
- 3. Is sustainable in each of these key areas -
  - School community health
  - Teaching and learning
  - Personnel
  - Finance

#### September

Adjustment of September calendar:

August 31 & September 1- Staff Only

Week One: September 2- 4 Early Dismissal for students

Monday, September 7- Labor Day/No School

Week Two: September 8 & 9 - Early Dismissal for students

September 10 & 11 - Full Days

## 1. General Health & Safety Guidelines

Califon School will follow the recommendations of the CDC, NJDOH and NJDOE and adhere to the following:

- Students & staff will stay home when not feeling well.
- Students & staff will be screened daily.
- Social distancing and mask wearing when social distancing is not possible.
- Hand washing & sanitizing will be reinforced.
- Measures to limit gatherings such as arrival & dismissal will be followed.
- Measures to limit outside contact (visitors, assemblies, etc) will be implemented.

\*Accommodations will be provided for high risk individuals or for those which wearing a mask is medically contraindicated.

## 2. Classrooms, Therapy & Testing Rooms

Califon School will follow the CDC, NJDOH & NJDOE guidance for measures in the school environment which include:

- Classroom environments will be arranged to maximize social distancing.
- Students will remain in their classroom for all subjects except physical education.
- "Special area" subject teachers will travel to the students.
- Lunch will take place in classroom or outside as a class.
- Recess will take place in designated play areas for each class.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available in all classrooms & outside restrooms throughout the school.
- Therapy rooms & offices will include the use of plexiglass barriers.

#### 3. Transportation

Transportation is <u>not</u> an area of consideration for Califon School, however, the school does rely on busing for trips and activities.

At this time, no trips or activities will take place.

### 4. Student Flow, Entry, Exit & Common Areas

Califon School will follow the CDC, NJDOH & NJDOE guidance for student flow, entry, exit & common areas which include:

- Limit large gatherings by utilizing multiple doors & staggering arrival/dismissal times.
  - Arrival A-K (8:10-8:20) And L-Z (8:20-8:30)
  - Dismissal A-K (3:12) And L-Z (3:20)
- Hallway traffic will be limited & utilize a one-way traffic pattern.
- Lunch will take place in classrooms.
- Recess areas will be designated for grade levels.

#### 5. Screening, PPE & Response to Students & Staff Presenting Symptoms

Califon School will follow the CDC, NJDOH & NJDOE guidance for measures in screening, PPE & response to illness which include:

- All Staff will wear masks.
- Students will wear masks at arrival, dismissal & during the day when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Staff will be screened daily upon arrival by the nurse.
- Students will be screened at home & reported by parents to the nurse daily.
- Staff will visually screen students upon arrival.
- Students that are symptomatic will be referred to the nurse & isolated until parent can pick up the child.

## 6. Contact Tracing

Califon School will follow the CDC, NJDOH & NJDOE guidance for requirements in contact tracing which include providing the following information to the Hunterdon County DOH upon request.

- Staff contact information
- Parent contact information
- School logs

The process includes a report from the doctor directly to the DOH, contact with the school & contact with individuals who may have been exposed. Individual privacy is maintained in the process.

Contact tracing is mandated by the NJDOH for all communicable diseases & public health emergencies. Schools are also required to report known cases to the NJDOH.

## 7. Facilities Cleaning Practice

Califon School will follow the CDC, NJDOH & NJDOE guidance for facility cleaning practices which include:

- Training for custodial staff regarding protocols.
- Increased sanitization throughout the day for all areas in building including restrooms, and frequent contact surfaces.
- Daily sanitization of playground equipment.
- Cleaning protocols utilizing EPA COVID-19 effective products.
- Shut off hand dryer blowers and install paper towels in restrooms.
- Shut off drinking fountains except bottle filler station.
- Provide hand sanitizer throughout the building and in classrooms.

#### 8. Meals

Although the Califon School does not have a meal service program, Califon School will follow the CDC, NJDOH & NJDOE guidance on serving of any food item which include:

- Continuation of the milk program utilizing safe handling practices.
- Reinforcement of "no food treats from home" practice.
- Reinforcement of "no sharing of food" practice.
- Lunch in classrooms/outside to begin the year.
- Delay in the PTA lunch program until safe practices are established such as pre-packaging at the restaurant.
- Delay the "going home for lunch" practice.

#### 9.Recess/Physical Education

It is important for students to continue with physical activity during the day. Califon School will follow the CDC, NJDOH & NJDOE guidance for practices in recess & physical education which include:

- No mixing of grade levels for recess or physical education.
- Recess areas in designated areas per grade.
- Social distancing and/or mask wearing.
- Sanitization of equipment after individual use.
- Outdoor Physical education weather permitting.

#### 10.Field Trips, Extra-Curricular Activities & Use of Facilities outside of School Hours

Califon School will follow the CDC, NJDOH & NJDOE guidance for field trips, activities & facilities use which include:

- No field trips
- No in-person extra-curricular activities
- Virtual clubs
- Virtual activities
- No outside use of facilities other than potential aftercare from 3-6pm daily.

# Next Steps:

- Identify important Califon traditions & methods to continue those traditions in a safe & compliant manner.
- Review & update Remote Learning Plan
- Prepare for **Social Emotional Learning** needs of students
- Planning for assessments to identify learning needs and/or gaps
- Identify & plan for students who may not return to in-person instruction
- Determine need & finalize aftercare program
- Identify & prepare for staff support
- Communicate opening information to parents
