

Due to COVID-19 procedures in place at the school we are constantly looking for ways to improve our new way of making sure our students, faculty and guests remain safe. One of the areas we are going to modify is the drop off procedure in the mornings in an attempt to reduce traffic congestion. Parents traveling Northbound on Hwy 105 from Ozark will be directed in front of the school by the SRO Deputy to CR-323 (in front of Skipperville Post Office) which will loop back into CR-33. The drop off line will utilize CR-323 to alleviate traffic congestion off of Hwy 105. For the remainder of the week our partners at the Dale County Sheriff's Office will have deputies directing you where to go. We are in the process of developing signage to go along the route as well. We would encourage all parents who are entering the carline to do so via the Hwy 105 southbound lane (H&W Store side). Only after 7:30 will northbound traffic be able to turn in the school from HWY 105. As a reminder students who drive do not have to enter the carline. They are asked to bypass the line and enter the parking lot. We appreciate everyone's cooperation and patience.
