

HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

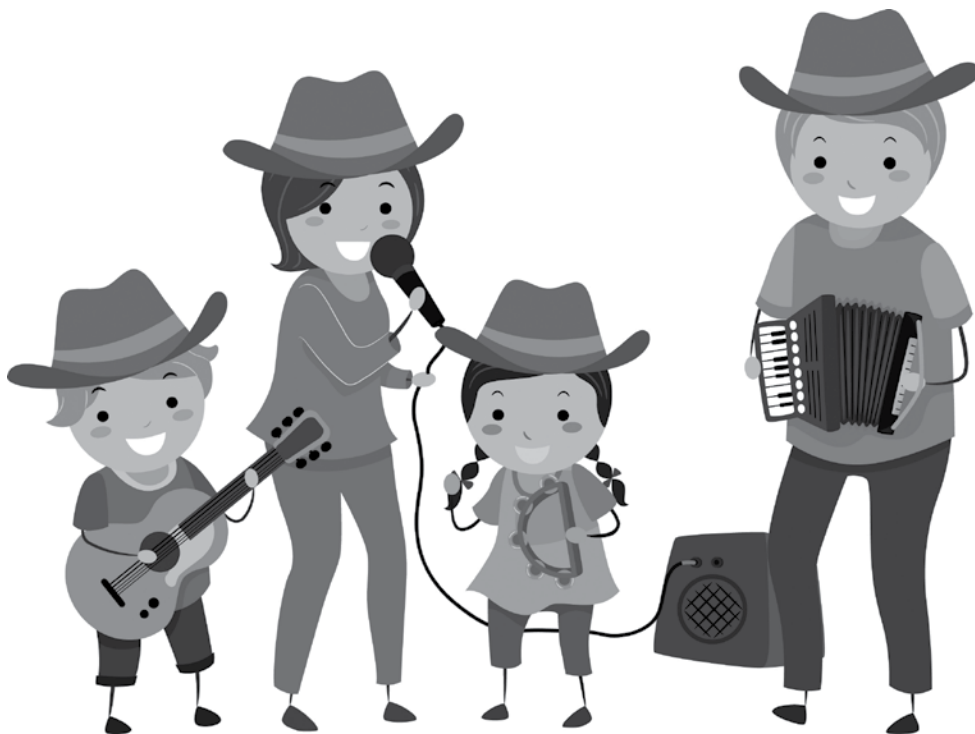

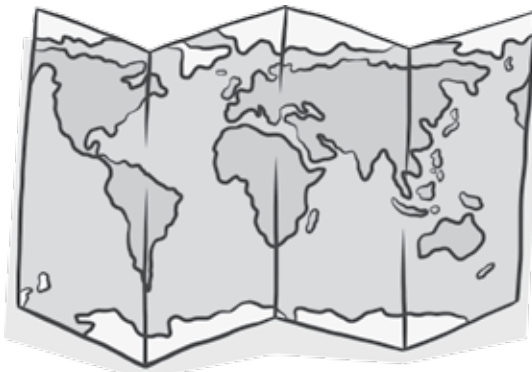
