If a student is not abiding by the expectations/rules that was reviewed with them please follow this flow sheet:

Conversation with counselor(s)
about their behavior.
Redirect and use positive
reinforcement to change the
behavior.

Conversation with Songbird (Miss
Collins) about their behavior
during a privilege (recreation/lunch
without group/ campfire)

Parent pick up, admin pickup
or they will sit out with a staff
member for the rest of the
day and won't be allowed
back the following day(s).

Learning

- Field studies are academic lessons based on outdoor activities.

Water Study with Sasquatch (Mr.Pinkstaff)

Students will learn about the water cycle and get to test water from the creek.
