#### MISSION

It is the mission of the GHS Class of 1981 to encourage, incentivize, and inspire graduating seniors to pursue their academic or vocational goals.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

The Scholarship Committee will award three (4) \$500 scholarships to any GHS graduating senior that intends to attend:

- 1. Four-year College or University
- 2. Two-Year Junior College
- 3. Vocational or Technical Training Program.

\*One scholarship per student

### ELIGIBILITY

Individual seniors from the GHS graduating class of 2021 are eligible for one of four \$500 scholarships.

### CRITERIA

- 1. Graduating senior\*
- 2. 2.5 Grade Point Average\*
- 3. One (1) Page Essay (grammar, spelling)\*
- 4. Examples of Student Intra-curricula & Extra-curricula Leadership (e.g., SGA, 4-H, JROTC, etc.)\*\*
- 5. Examples of Student Volunteerism (e.g., Scouts, Meals-on-Wheels, Caregiver, Public Library, etc.)\*\*
- 6. Work experience\*\*

\*Required

\*\*Any combination of these criteria can help boost a student's chances of winning; it is in each student's best interest to submit as much material as possible.

- 2. Submissions received after April 30, 2021, will not be considered.

#### SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

GHS Class of 1981 \$500 Scholarship

On a sheet of paper separate from your essay, please provide or verify items 1, 2, & 4-6.

- 1. You are a GHS graduating senior.
- 2. Verify your current Grade Point Average (must come from a counselor)
- 3. Write a one-page (1.5 space, 12pt font) essay addressing the following question: "Should the law require women to register for selective service after their eighteenth birthday, or should the law continue to require only men to register for selective service after their eighteenth birthday?" Make arguments for one or the other proposition.
- 4. Provide examples of intra-curricula and extra-curricula leadership
- 5. Provide examples of volunteerism
- 6. Provide examples of work experience
