

Welcome back BCHS Warriors!!

It is our goal to open our doors to BCHS students with their safety and wellbeing at the forefront. It is with this in mind that you will see how our opening plan is designed to facilitate our day and keep everyone safe and healthy.

Very Important: It is advised to take temperature before coming to school because anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater will be sent home.

Cleaning routine: As you might have expected, additional cleaning procedures will be designated and specific training has occurred for our custodial staff to keep everyone safe. Bathrooms have scheduled cleaning times and high touch areas will be disinfected routinely throughout the day.

Arrival routine: 7:10-7:45

Students will be greeted by BCHS faculty and administrators. As they exit the buses, a member of our team will take your student's temperature. Each bus rider will enter the main entrance with double doors. As he/she enters the building, a faculty member will direct him/her to one of three areas: auditorium, gym, and cafeteria. A seating chart will be made at this point to assist with contact tracing if needed. Those who drive will enter beside the assistant principal's office after temperatures have been taken and directed to designated areas. When the bell rings, students will be dismissed to his/her first period, grab and go breakfasts will be provided and eaten in his/her classroom.

Hallway/Classroom/Shop routine:

Hallways have designated social distancing with one-way traffic patterns to limit exposure.

- Students' desks will be separated as much as possible in order to promote social distancing and optimal learning.
- Cleaning of desks and shared spaces will occur at each class exchange.
- **Masks** are mandatory for faculty and staff members.. All students are required to wear masks in common areas and when social distancing cannot be practiced.
- Student seating charts will be kept to maintain a record of student interactions in the case of needed contact tracing.
- Classes are provided with scheduled restroom opportunities throughout the day to limit contact among other classes.

Lunchroom routine:

Lunch count will be taken in the morning. Students will choose either hot or cold lunch. Students will eat in his/her classroom during 4th period unless designated to eat in the cafeteria or other area. The cafeteria staff along with other faculty and staff will assist with the distribution of lunches.

Afternoon dismissal:

BCHS students will remain in the classroom and be called to his/her bus. As each bus is called, students will exit the building. Buses will have designated locations. Following bus dismissal, car riders and drivers will be dismissed. Athletes will remain in the classroom until car riders and drivers are dismissed.
