

Title: 2020-21 Lunch Prices

According to the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) regulations, school food authorities (SFA's) participating in the NSLP are required to ensure that sufficient funds are provided to the nonprofit school food service account for meals served to students not eligible for free or reduced price meals. Therefore, SFA's must annually review their paid lunch revenue to assure compliance with the paid lunch equity requirement. In order to be in compliance with this regulation Rocky Hill must increase our lunch prices by .10 cents. This brings our lunch price to \$2.90 at the elementary schools and \$3.15 at the middle and high schools for the 2020-21 school year.
