Below are some lesson activities from the GA Best Employability Skills program that will help you develop skills that will help you be successful in school and in your present or future workplace.

### **Conflict Resolution/Flexibility**

This activity will help you to understand how having the ability to be flexible can help you to resolve conflicts.

**Directions:** Take a moment to think about times in your life when you faced a conflict and how you handled the conflict. After reflecting, read the definition of flexibility and complete the Barriers to Resolving Conflict worksheet. You may email me the completed worksheet.

**What is flexibility?** *The ability to adapt; display a teachable heart and willingness to change or compromise; to be receptive to new information; the ability to learn from mistakes for the benefit of self and the employer.*
