- 1. The hot water heater was installed in 1994. Because of the age of this piece of equipment, it makes me worry about how much longer before it fails. I would assume if we didn't have hot water we couldn't have school? I haven't spent a ton of time on this but from my research a new one similar to what we have costs about \$9,500.00 which doesn't include installation. If this is something which would be considered I would look further into it to see about rebates and also look at other options for a more efficient unit.
- 2. Direct drive heat pump for the old gym unit. Original pump has been giving us problems, a direct drive pump would eliminate the coupler. Cost is about \$3,000.
- 3. Roof repairs over special education department
- 4. Lockers 40 new lockers to sustain growth from elementary and secondary students. (\$6,400)
- 5. Painting of the old gym Remove banners and repaint all of the walls. The carpet on the west wall would have to be researched.
- 6. Auditorium Seating, painting, ceiling, electrical upgrades, stage curtains cleaning.
- 7. Elementary classroom updates to laminate cupboards and countertops.
- 8. Window tinting in office area for security purposes.
