Dear Red Rock Day School Family,

Your child's safety and the safety of our school staff is our foremost priority. I'm writing to update you on our school water supply. Red Rock Day School is still experiencing an issue with our campus water supply system. The wells are currently pumping a low volume of water, and the water tanks are not recovering as quickly we need them too. Therefore, the school is (and will remain) on limited water usage until the problem can be adequately addressed.

The steps taken to address the concern: Shiprock Agency Facility Management, NTUA, Iinaba Inc. and RRDS are working together. There are two plans (Emergency Plan and Long Term Plan). All parties understand that water is required to ensure the daily functioning of the school (drinking, cooking, cleaning, restrooms, etc.).

While the school works through the process of getting plans approved and funding allocated, we must delay transitioning to Phase II (Hybrid) Model of Instruction – student here part of the day Monday to Friday) but please be assured that we are working to get the concerns addressed as quickly as possible. This means we will begin the school year with remote instruction (Starting August 2, 2021) like we did last year (hopefully, not for long). As with our previous distance learning phase, five breakfasts, five lunches, and student Learning Support Kits will be delivered on Monday of each week. Teachers will follow a WebEx schedule (virtual meeting time) to meet with your child.

RRDS thanks you for your patience and understanding. We will keep you informed as the work continues. We understand that you want and deserve what is best for your family; therefore, we want to be transparent in the process. Please know that RRDS is working with Facility Management, Iinaba Inc. and NTUA to address this matter as quickly as possible. RRDS wants all of our students and staff to learn in a safe and comfortable learning environment.
