

# Elementary SSD Academic Options Flowchart

## Begin with Comprehensive Distance Learning

Situation 1

Parents Have Two Options in Fall 2020

### Seaside School District Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL)

*(Instruction online by SSD teachers using live and recorded lessons with programs such as: Canvas, Stemscoptes, My Math, eSpark, Seesaw)*

Students are assigned to a classroom teacher and a class with peers.

### Seaside School District Online Thrive Program

*(An Online curriculum will be used, TBA)*

Parents or another adult provide daily academic support for their child. SSD staff check-in with families 2X per week. Students are NOT assigned to a class with peers. This is a year-long program.

Situation 2

When/if we Have the Metrics to Open

### Seaside School District Hybrid Model

*(Normal Classroom Curricula + Online Programs such as: Canvas, Stemscoptes, My Math, eSpark, Seesaw)*

Students are assigned to a classroom teacher and a class with peers.

If an individual tests positive for Covid-19, the student continues online with with the programs above. Student returns to Hybrid when recovered.

If a cohort tests positive for Covid-19, cohort continues online with online programs above. Cohort returns to Hybrid when recovered.

Students may choose to transfer between the two options (CDL or Online Thrive) at the beginning of a trimester.
