Qualifications/Expectations:

Applicants must possess competent coaching skills in Track and Field. Preference will be given to applicants with teaching/coaching experience, but this is not a requirement. Coaches are responsible for the day-to-day operation of the program and other program related duties. These duties can range from drill instruction and execution to video study and analysis. Coaches are expected to demonstrate effective teaching skills relative to sport-specific technique, as well as possess the interpersonal skills necessary to maintain effective working relationships with students, parents, other coaches, and administrators. Essential responsibilities also include modeling appropriate behavior and following established protocol for injuries. This position will report to the High School Activity Coordinator.
