

# 12th Grade Need to Know Checklist....

- Panel Pictures** will be taken before school starts in August.
  - These may be purchased if you wish.
- Jostens Order:** Jostens will be at the school for orders in August.  
(Deposit: \$80)
  - **Cap & Gown, Announcements, and Senior Year Keepsakes**
    - Prices will vary.
- Vision Bank **Academic Letterman** Jackets
  - Apply and interviews are in September
  - Jackets are ordered September/October
- All Prague students that are Native American that have a CDIB card, check with Sac 'n Fox for items they may reimburse for; example: Class rings, Letterman Jackets, Announcements, Cap and Gowns, etc.

  - ACT Academy – Free test prep ( [www.academy.act.org](http://www.academy.act.org) )
  - If you qualify for Free & Reduced lunches, you can receive two (2) ACT fee waivers. (See Ms Baker for waivers.)
  - School Code: 372-940
- Visit [www.okcollegestart.org](http://www.okcollegestart.org) to create an account and start your profile. There are approximately 20,000 scholarships to apply for.
  - There is a FREE ACT test prep on this website.
- No State Testing required for 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Seniors have two (2) Free College Visits (excused absence)
  - Must bring proof to Mrs. Dean that you were at the college.
- If you qualify for Free & Reduced Lunches, you will possibly have a waiver for college application fees. (See Ms Baker about which colleges allow waivers.)

- Local Scholarship Applications will be handed out in January. (More information in Ms Baker's office.)
- You will need a copy of your Official High School Transcript to attach with most scholarship applications.
  - Try to give Mrs. Dean a couple of days' notice when requesting transcripts.
- CPR Training** is required by the State of Oklahoma for graduation. The school will provide the training.
- NCAA/NAIA:** Make sure all NCAA/NAIA are being met and you are signed up online at [www.NCAA.org](http://www.NCAA.org)
  - Cost: \$80 (There is a fee waiver available, see website for more details)
- Remember* to keep a list of all awards, community service and their dates, this will help you during your Senior Year.

# TimeLine for Senior Year

- August:**           ~Panel Pictures (before school starts)  
~Jostens Product Orders (Cap & Gown, Announcements, Etc.)
- September:**       ~Apply to colleges of choice.
- October:**           ~December: Apply to FASFA (Financial Aid)  
~After December 1<sup>st</sup> all the state monies will be given out.  
Ms Baker will provide a FASFA representative in October to help you file.
- December:**         ~Deadline to apply to the University of Oklahoma.  
~Make sure you have ordered your Cap & Gown, any orders after December will cost \$20 more to expedite the order.
- January:**           ~Deadline for PLC (Presidential Leadership Council) scholarship and Honors Program Scholarship  
~CPR Training for graduation
- February:**         ~by the 1<sup>st</sup> most college scholarships are due.  
~Remember to apply for the college's foundation scholarships too. (\*\*Ask your Academic Admissions how to find those. \*\*)  
~Apply for tribal scholarships if you have a CDIB Card. Remember to check with each tribe for foundation scholarships.
- March:**             ~Prom (Subject to Change)
- April:**             ~Senior Trip (Subject to Change)

- May:**               ~Baccalaureate
