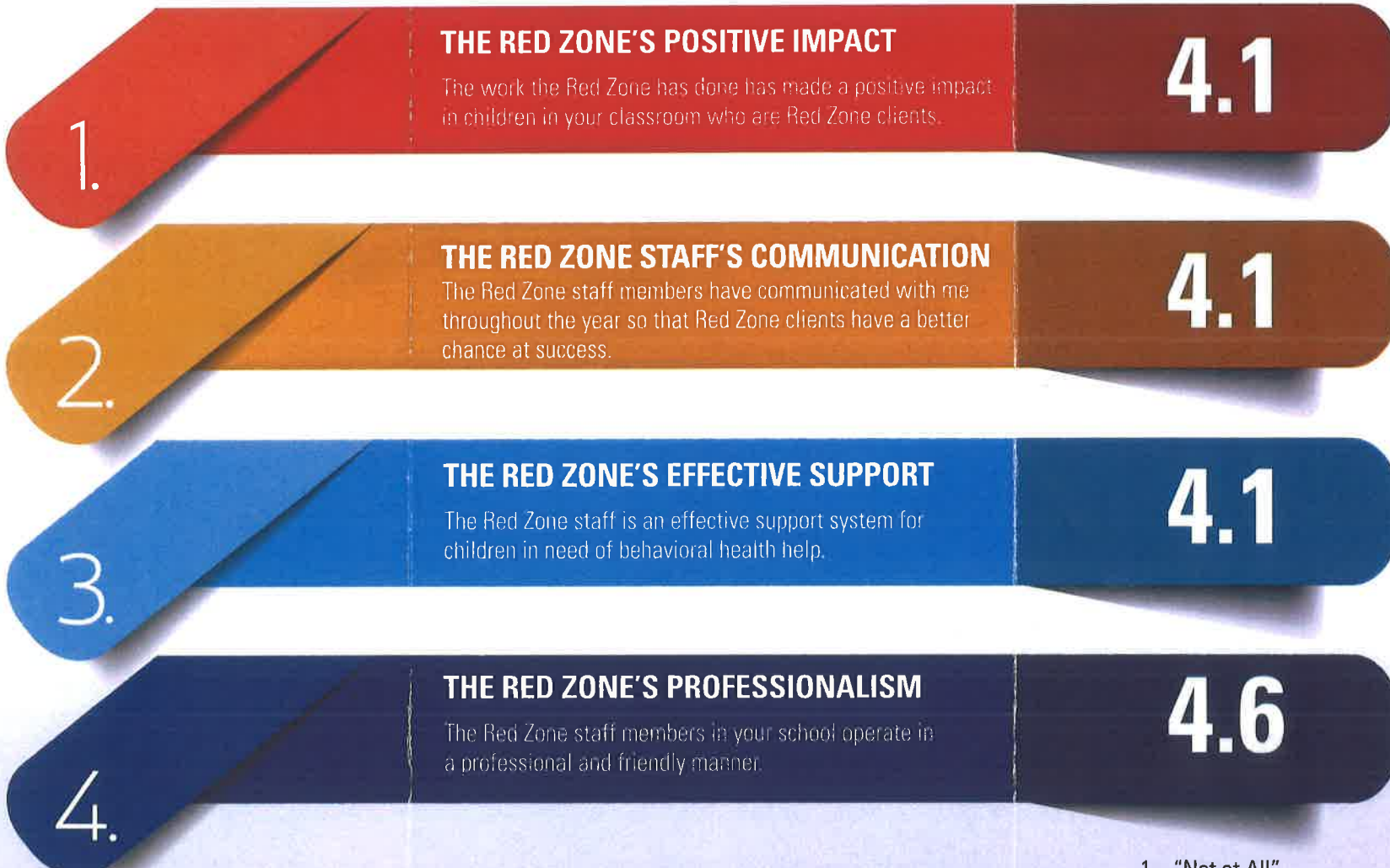

THE AVERAGE GPA FOR THE RED ZONE PARTICIPANTS INCREASED FROM 2.42 TO 2.82!

Improved behavioral health has many positive side effects. John LaPlante, Chief Information Officer for the Youngstown City Schools, analyzed GPA data comparing the 2016-17 school year to the 2017-18 school year. The average GPA for The Red Zone participants increased from 2.42 to 2.82!
