# You should bring the following items to the exam room:



Several sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers for all responses on your multiple-choice answer sheet.



Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.

Your 6-digit school code which is 070545. Homeschooled students will use the following code, Connecticut – 990799, New York - 993399.

- Homeschooled and out of district students must bring a valid photo identification.
- A watch that does not have internet access, does not beep, and does not have an
- Up to two approved calculators with the necessary capabilities if you're taking an AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics Exam. Visit exploreap.org/calculatorpolicy) to learn more about the calculator policy for each of these exams and for a list of authorized calculators.
- A ruler or straightedge **only** if you're taking an AP Physics Exam. Protractors are not allowed.
- If you've been approved for testing accommodations, bring your SSD Student Accommodation letter to verify your approval.

# You should not bring the following to the exam room\*:

- Electronic equipment (cell phone, smartphone, smartwatch, laptop, tablet computer, etc.), portable listening or recording devices (MP3 player, iPod, etc.), cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, or other electronic or communication devices. School-owned recording devices and equipment are allowed only for the AP French, German, Italian, and Spanish Language and Culture Exams and the AP Music Theory Exam.
- Books, compasses, protractors, mechanical pencils, No. 3 pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, or colored pencils.

### You should not bring the following to the exam room\*:

- Scratch paper; notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets or, for Chinese Language and Culture and Japanese Language and Culture **only**, on scratch paper provided by the proctor.
- Watches that beep or have an alarm.
- Computers.
- Protractors.
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Ear plugs.
- Clothing or shoes with subject-related information.
- Clipboards.

\*Unless this has been preapproved as an accommodation by the College Board Services for Students with Disabilities office prior to the test date.

You are required to arrive at the times stated on this schedule. Students <u>may not</u> be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation, and arrangements should be made accordingly as some exams may run until 4:00 pm.

Get a good night's rest before your exam, and eat a nutritious breakfast. You are allowed to bring a snack and beverage for your 10-minute break. However, food and drink are prohibited in the exam room. It is advisable to bring a sweater, in case the room temperature is below your comfort level.

You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and New Milford High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam grade.
