Some highlights from the meeting are:

- * The cookbook project is nearing completion. There will be a proofreading, checking over, etc. session on October 24th beginning at 6:00 PM in the HS library. Over 500 recipes were submitted.
- * Katie Kleven and Dewey Swanson are working on the lead story for the fall “Connections”
- * November 13th is the date for the American Education Week light luncheon that will be served to all school personnel
- * \$2500 from the last all school reunion had been given to the Foundation in 2005 “to keep” for the next reunion. This amount was turned over to the 2019 reunion committee.
- The Warren Area Community Fund Grant Application for guided reading books was completed and submitted.
- The Scholastic Book Club has a program where \$1.00 books can be purchased so that every child in the class receives a book each month. Preschool through second grade already has

sponsors for their classes. Approval was given for money from the CJ Anderson Endowment to fund this project for grades 3-6.

- Aaron Wall requested permission to give the birding supplies that the Foundation funded a few years ago to Godel Library to be used by all. This program will be taken over by Heidi Hughes and the Agassiz Audubon.
- The annual Baked Potato/Salad Bar Supper will be on January 7th. Mary Stanislawski will again donate the potatoes.
- Fall needs in the amount of \$13,944 were approved. A list is attached. Many board members were not in attendance, but had shared their votes through texts/e-mails.
- Memorials and donations for September were approved.
