NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Sumter County Board of Education has tentatively adopted a 2016 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 4.11 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at the Sumter County School Board Office, 100 Learning Lane, Americus, Georgia on July 20, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Time and place of additional public hearing on this tax increase is at Sumter County Board of Education, 100 Learning Lane, Americus, Georgia on July 27, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. Immediately following the hearing there will be a called meeting to set the millage rate.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 18.253 mills, an increase of .72 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 17.533 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$250,000 is approximately \$72.00 and the proposed tax increase for a nonhomestead property with a fair market value of \$175,000 is approximately \$50.40.
