








General Illness Protocol

Students and staff must stay home or leave school for the following:

						
FEVER	VOMITING	DIARRHEA	RASH	HEAD LICE	EYE INFECTION	HOSPITAL STAY AND/OR ER VISIT
Temperature of 100.0 or higher	Within the past 24 hours	Within the past 24 hours	Body rash with itching or fever	Itchy head, active head lice	Redness, Itching, and/or "crusty" drainage from eye	Hospital stay and/or ER visit

Students and staff may return to school if the following criteria are met:

Fever free for 24 hours <u>without the use of fever reducing medication</u> i.e. Tylenol, Motrin	Free from vomiting for at least 2 solid meals	Free from diarrhea for at least 24 hours	Free from rash itching, or fever. I have been evaluated by my doctor if needed.	Treated with appropriate lice treatment at home and proof is provided to nurse.	Evaluated by my doctor and have note to return to school.	Released by medical provider to return to work or school.
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COVID-19 Protocol

Updated: 8/27/20

Any symptomatic student or staff member who tests negative for COVID-19 **and is not a close contact** of a positive case, can return to school following the general illness guidelines above, or if they obtain a note from their healthcare provider permitting the return to school based on an alternative diagnosis.

Any student or staff member with a positive COVID-19 test or symptoms of COVID-19 must stay home until all three of the following criteria are met:

- 1—At least ten (10) days have passed since symptoms first started.
- 2—At least 24 hours have passed since fever resolved **without the use of fever-reducing medications (e.g., Acetaminophen, Ibuprofen)**.
- 3—Symptoms such as cough or shortness of breath have improved or resolved.

Using legal confidentiality requirements, any positive COVID-19 result will initiate contact tracing and notification of close contacts such as teachers, pods, and families.
