Motion Parrott, second Yearout to employ Hillary Heimsoth as part-time special services secretary for the 2016-2017 school year. Roll call vote of motion carried as follows: Yearout-yes; Sell-yes; Parrott-yes; Beaman-yes; Eckhoff-yes; Kroenke-yes; and Mehrens-yes. Motion carried 7 yes, 0 no.

Mrs. Eifert requested permission from the board to employ part-time preschool aides as soon as possible. It was the consensus of the board that Mrs. Eifert fill these positions with the best candidates available.

There being no further business for executive session a motion was made by Parrott, seconded by Kroenke to adjourn the executive session at 8:34 P.M.
