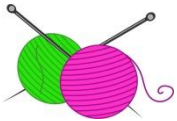
**DONUTS AND DOCTRINE** Has concluded and will return in the Fall.

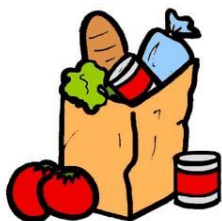


**SVDP MEETING**: Our next meeting is Sunday, June 13th.
