

## Yazoo County Middle School 6th-8th Grade Supply List

**(This list should cover the basic supplies needed for middle school).**

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- (1) 2 in. binder (**for 6th Grade Science**)
- (1) 1 1/2 in. binder (**for 6th Grade other subjects**)
- (2) 1 1/2 in. binder (**for all 7th and 8th Grade subjects**)
- 2 packs loose-leaf notebook paper (for binders)\* Paper can be replenished as needed.
- 1 pack of graph paper (for Math)
- 2 composition notebooks (**no spiral bound**)
- (3) 3-prong **PLASTIC** folders with pockets
- A pack of post-it notes (turn in to ELA teacher)
- Tab dividers (at least 10 tabs or 2 packs of 5 tabs for binders)
- Mesh binder pencil bags **are optional** to hold the following **required items\***:
  - Pencils\* (Ticonderoga or USA Gold brand)
  - Pink erasers\*
  - A calculator for **Math class** (Nothing expensive...The Dollar Store or Walmart has some)
    - **6th and 7th Grade** may have one that adds, subtracts, multiplies, divides, does percentages and square roots, and has the +/- button (**NO SCIENTIFIC CALCULATORS**)\*
    - **8th Grade** may have a scientific calculator (**NO GRAPHING CALCULATORS**)\*
  - Highlighters\* (used daily in ELA)
  - Dry Erase Markers (used in multiple classes)
  - Handheld pencil sharpener
- Plastic box (optional to hold the following **required supplies\***) Please get one that will fit in a backpack and label it with the student's name.
  - Colored Pencils\*, Markers\*, Scissors\*, Ruler\*, and Protractor\*
  - (3) 2-packs Glue sticks
- 1 box of Kleenex (turn in to homeroom teacher)
- 1 box of Ziploc bags (Boys - quart size, Girls - gallon size)
- 1 pair of headphones/earbuds (Dollar Store has some...no wireless/Bluetooth headphones)\*
- 1 bookbag\* (to hold all supplies and school issued computer)

\*Students should have their supplies ready to bring to class as needed. Students should have these **supplies daily** in order to be successful in **their hands-on, interactive activities in classes**.
