



Office of Academic Affairs First Class Pre-K Pre-Registration 2021

The Mobile County Public School System’s First Class Pre-K online registration will open January 15, 2021. Pre-K pre-registration screening will be held during the month of March 2021. Students pre-registering for Pre-K must be four-years old on or before September 1, 2021.

All students pre-registering should have an original birth certificate. Parents/guardians must have a photo ID to pre-register their child and two proofs of residence. Students may pre-register for any one of the Title I sites listed below since all schools do not have Pre-K. Students pre-registering for Pre-K may attend a pre-registration screening at only one site. They must reside in a Title I attendance zone in order to pre-register. Please visit mcps.com for information regarding screening dates/sites and to complete the online pre-registration which opens January 15, 2021. The online application closes February 28, 2021. Visit mcps.com, “Apply for Pre-K Programs”, complete the online application and “note” one of the “Screening Sites and Dates” listed during the month of March. Your child must complete the onsite screening in order to be considered for the Mobile County Public School System Pre-K program.

Pre-K Students who live in the "Non-Title I" elementary school zones (**Allentown, Austin, Dauphin Island and Hutchens**) and Title I zones may complete a Pre-K application for the sites listed below. The applications for the sites below will be available at mcps.com and <https://alprek.asapconnected.com> as well as each school’s website beginning January 15, 2021. Random selection drawings will be held during the month of March. Once students are selected, parents must provide an **original birth certificate** and two proofs of residence.
