



**Important Notice to Parents
Armed Forces Recruiter Access to Students
and Student Recruiting Information**

The "No Child Left Behind Act of 2001" passed certain new requirements with respect to Armed Forces Recruiter Access to Students and Student Recruiting Information.

1. **Duty to Provide Information to Military Recruiters.** Unless the parent/guardian or student otherwise requests, the district is mandated to provide military recruiters access to high school students' names, home addresses, and home telephone listings.
2. **Consent.** Either the high school student or the parent/guardian of the student may request that the student's name, address, and telephone listing not be released without prior consent. Schools are required to notify parents/guardians of this option to make a request and shall comply with the request.
3. **Access to Students.** Each district shall provide military recruiters the same access to high school students as is provided generally to higher education institutions, community colleges, and prospective employers unless otherwise requested by parents/guardians.

Your statement of objection or consent will be placed in your student's records. If a completed form is not received within ten days of your student's enrollment in Knappa High School, it will be assumed that permission to release the information has been granted. Remember, your student is always free to initiate contact with military representatives no matter what your decision.
