

Prattville High School 2020-2021 Roadmap to Reopen School

Communication:

- School Messenger: Principal callouts will be used to inform students and parents.
- Website: The PHS website will be updated with current information. www.gophslions.com
- Social Media: Remind will be used to notify all staff.
- Signage around the campus will be used to communicate and instruct students and parents.

Prevention Protocols:

- Sanitizing supplies and equipment are inventoried and ready to use.
- Hand Sanitizing Stations will be located in designated areas.
- Face Coverings: Masks are required for everyone. All masks must meet the school dress code. (No bandanas)
- Post signage in student areas on how to stop the spread of COVID 19.
- Post signage in restrooms on proper hand washing practices.
- Screening of students: Implement a three pronged approach: 1. Home (parents will complete the initial screening of temperature check and physical signs) 2. Transportation (Signage) 3. School (staff will monitor for signs)
- Students will transition on a block schedule daily.

Modified 8 Course Schedule:

Cardinal/White Days will rotate daily.

White Schedule will be 1st Period, 3rd Period, 5th Period, and 7th Period

Cardinal Schedule will be 2nd Period, 4th Period, 6th Period, and 8th Period

1st Block	7:50- 9:25	1st and 2nd
2nd Block	9:30-11:05	3rd and 4th
3rd Block	11:10-1:05	5th and 6th
4th Block	1:10-2:45	7th and 8th

****lunch will take place during the 3rd Block.**

Morning Procedures:

- Students will not be allowed on campus until 7:15 am. Bus and car riders will not be allowed in the building prior to the 7:15.
- Students receiving breakfast will report to the lunchroom line to receive their breakfast and will then report to their assigned location.
- Students' not eating breakfast will report to the assigned location.
- Teachers on duty will report to their duty station at 7:15.
- Students will report to their 1st Period Classrooms starting at 7:30 and will not be allowed to continuously walk the hallways. Teachers will supervise students in their classrooms in order to monitor students until class starts at 7:50.

Class transitions:

- Masks are required. Everyone must wear a facial covering.
- Students will have 5 minutes to transition classes.
- Hallways will be divided in half for directional traffic.
- Student Lockers will not be used during the school year.

Lunch Transitions:

- Students will walk to the lunchroom with their teacher in order to pick up their meal and return to the classroom for lunch.
- Teachers will be assigned transition times for lunch arrival and each teacher will keep up with their 20 minute lunch time.

School Dismissal:

- Fourth Block will end at 2:45.
- Students will remain with the teacher until their bus wave arrives.
(Transportation will determine waves)
- Car Riders will be dismissed between bus waves.

Student Transportation:

- No Field Trips until further notice.
- Athletics and Extra Curricular COVID -19 Plans will be followed.

Attendance:

- BOE approved a waiver for the 2020-2021 Exemption policy.
- Students will follow the quarantine guidelines in the ACBOE Roadmap.

Entry/Exit School Campus:

- Staff and students will wear masks.
- Sanitizing stations at the school entrance.
- No outside food deliveries to campus.
- Bus riders will enter the school building at the entrances closest to the bus line.
- Car riders will enter the school building at the main entrance only.
- Visitor restrictions will apply.

Large Group Gatherings:

- No club schedules during the school day.
- Large assemblies will not be allowed.

Student Learning:

- Schoology will be our learning platform for both modified traditional and virtual students
- Virtual lessons will be included in weekly instruction for modified traditional students.
- Group activities will be kept to a minimum.
- Virtual students: parents must provide internet and a device for the virtual option.
- E-learning days will be used throughout the school year.
- Some electives will require attendance on campus. (band, yearbook, JROTC and athletics)
- Transitions between virtual and modified traditional instruction should only take place at the end of the grading period.

Physical Education:

- No locker rooms or dressing out
- Social distancing should take place as much as possible
- Equipment will be disinfected.
- Activities will include indoor and outdoor lessons to provide adequate space for teachers and students.
