

Some dates to remember (so far) for the end of this 'DIFFERENT' kind of school year:

1. Any retention letters and summer school notes must be digitally turned into your homeroom teacher by Thursday May 14th
2. Mon. May 11th will be a day for students to drop off work at the MS from 8AM to 8PM in the drop box.
3. Mon. May 18th will be a day for students to drop off ALL their work at the MS from 8AM to 8PM in the drop box.
3. Students who are all caught up will be FINISHED with school as of the 15th if their teacher approves of the quality of work turned in on May 15th - those not caught up will need to use the last week (May 18-21) to complete all required work.
4. Monday May 18th
 - Chromebook turn in at HS cafeteria 10-1 and 5-7
 - 6:30 PM 5th grade celebration parade. 5th graders will line up in their parents' cars at the beginning of North Stadium Drive at 6:15. All parade 'watchers' may park down both sides of Stadium Drive from Main St. (Franklin) all the way through to the south exit off of Stadium Drive back on to Franklin. 5th grade parents may make 2 laps through the processional. Any attendees MUST stay parked until all 5th grade students have driven through the processional 2 times.
5. Tues May 19th - Chromebook turn in @ HS cafeteria from 10-1 and 5-7
 - PK-2nd Cubby/Personal item pick up and library book or lunch charges drop off 4-6:30PM
 - Cubby Clean out and Library Book/Calculator returns/Lunch Charges Night(s):
