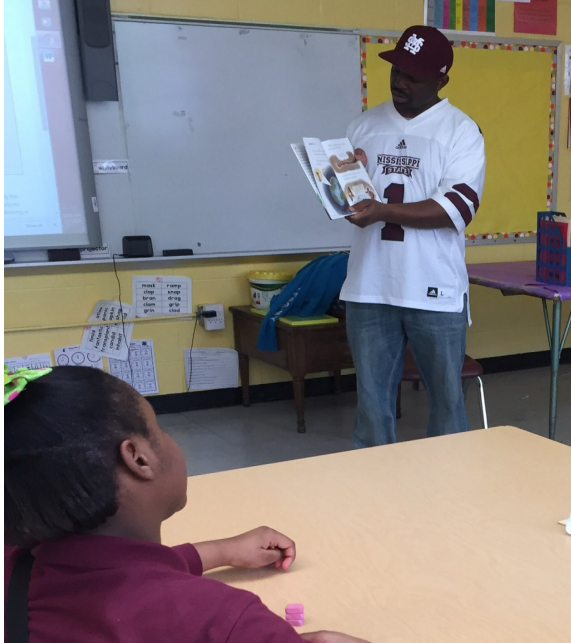
# Awards' Program

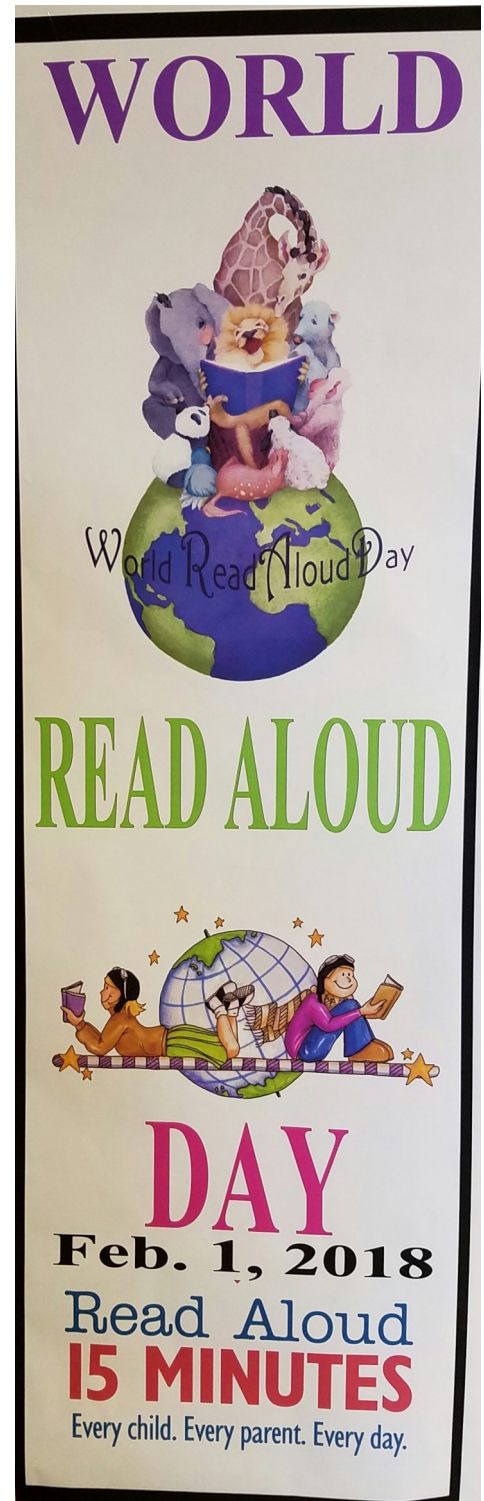
# World Read Aloud Day

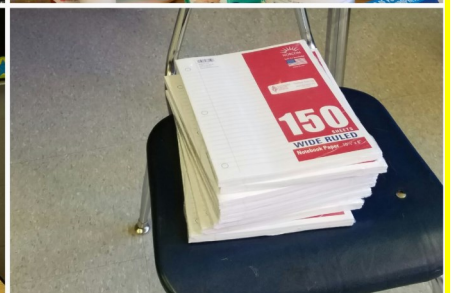
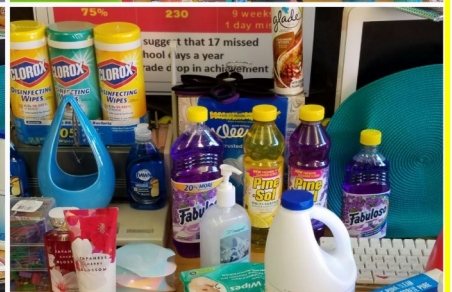
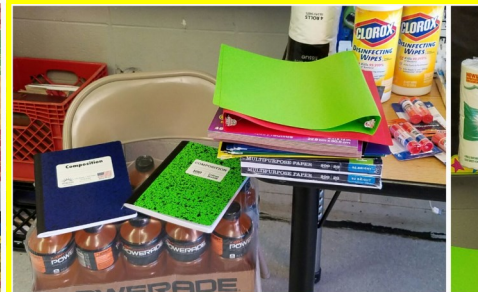




# Bulldog & Tiger Store

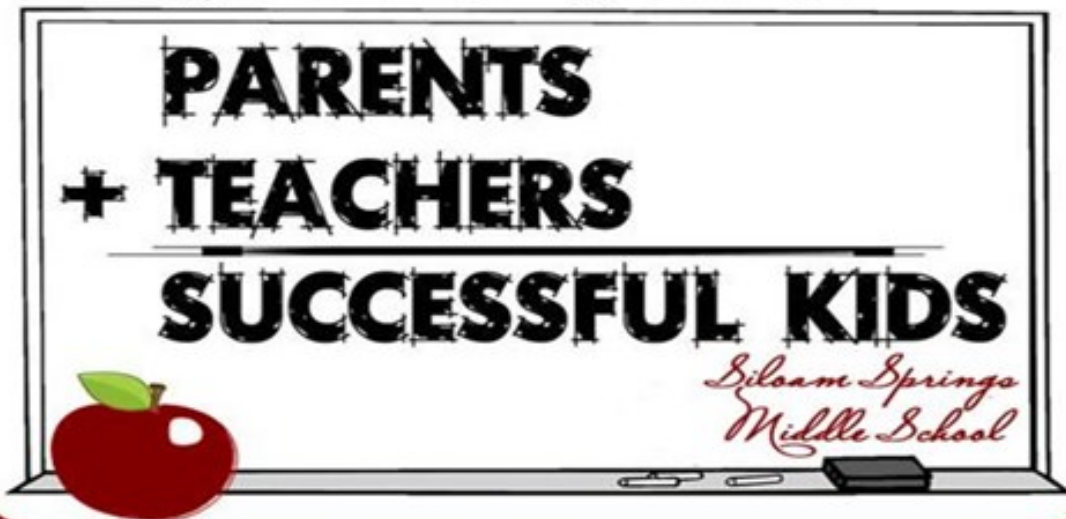
