

Dear Parents, Students, Family Members, and Guardians,



- Please make sure your child is dressed and ready to meet each day.
- A schedule will be provided for you.
- It is important to have a quiet and clean area for your child to work in.
- Please make sure your student is prepared with his or her materials (notebooks and pencils). They should have them each time they are ready for class.
- There should be no food or drinks near the work area.
- Please keep bathroom breaks to a minimum during our scheduled time.
- REMINDER: For those with other siblings or family members at home during our live sessions, please remember, if your child is unmuted....we can hear you.
- Please note that attendance will be taken and recorded.
- Assignments will be graded and recorded for the midterm and 9 week progress reports.
- Students should complete assignments. Parents are always encouraged to assist their child as needed, however, we do not expect you do do assignments for them.
- Headphones for your child to use during virtual classes will cut down on distractions and help them focus on what is going on during class sessions.
 These are not required but if available can be used.
- Parents, feel free to check in on your student to make sure they are on task during their online sessions, however, it is not necessary to sit with them the entire time they are online with their class or teacher. Doing so will make them more dependent upon you helping them during this process.

All students will have a google classroom set up for my class. One for ELA and one for Social Studies. This is where assignments and items for the week for them to work on or view will be located.
