

Cottage Hill Christian Academy Standardized Testing 2019-2020

PSAT/NMSQT -

- Administered to all sophomores and juniors in the fall.
- Juniors will take the official PSAT for National Merit qualification. PSAT scores are used to identify National Merit Scholars and award merit scholarships.
- Sophomores will take the PSAT as a practice preparation test.
- The date for this test is Wednesday, October 16, 2019.

PSAT8/9-

- Administered to all freshmen in the fall.
- Freshmen are introduced to standardized testing in high school through the PSAT8/9.
- The test is patterned after the PSAT/NMSQT and serves to introduce students to preparing for the ACT and/or SAT.
- The date for this test is Wednesday, October 16, 2019.

ACT -

- Administered to all juniors in the spring.
- Students should have taken the ACT at least once prior to this administration.
- Information will be distributed and discussed at the January Junior Parent meeting.
- The date for this test is Tuesday, March 24, 2020.

PreACT –

- Administered to freshmen and sophomores in the spring.
- The PreACT serves as an opportunity for students to see direct score predictions based on the same scale and content as the regular ACT. The PreACT has the same four multiple-choice sections as the regular ACT: English, Math, Reading, and Science. There is no Writing section. The test is also scored the same way as the regular ACT, on a scale from 1-36. The main difference is that it's considerably shorter.
- The date for this test is Tuesday, March 24, 2020.
