The ACT test is vitally important for college acceptance and scholarship purposes. Students can utilize the information from their PreACT results to determine how much preparation they need to do before taking the actual ACT. Juniors should have taken the ACT at least once before taking it with their class at the on campus administration. Seniors should continue to improve their scores the fall of their senior year.

With the exception of the CHCA on campus administration for juniors, students should register and pay online at www.act.org. On exam day, the student must have an acceptable form of photo I.D. and a printed ACT admission ticket with a photo printed on it. If the student does not have a valid photo I.D., he or she will need to download the [ACT Student Identification Letter](#) with Photo and have it completed by a school official.

ACT Test Prep is offered at CHCA and can be requested as an elective course sophomore, junior or senior years. There are also private tutors and ACT Test Prep camps available.
