

Class Behavior

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In order to give your child and all students in our classroom a safe, orderly, learning environments, we have to establish the following classroom behavior plan. Please review the classroom rules and consequences listed with your child. It is important for the student to know and understand what appropriate behavior is expected at school. During the first few days of school, we will spend time going over the procedures and discussing the behavior plan with students.

Classroom Rules

1. Listen and follow directions
2. Be polite, courteous, and respectful to everyone
3. Raise your hand and wait to be called on
4. Stay in your seat unless given permission to get up
5. Complete assignments/homework
6. Be prepared for class- books, materials, planner, etc.

Consequences

We believe in giving students a fair chance in controlling their behavior. However, when students continue to disrupt learning in the classroom, the following consequences will take place.

1st time- Verbal warning and a Guideline Infraction Notice

2nd time- 10 minute loss of recess time and complete an Action Plan- 1 check

3rd time- 20 minute loss of recess time - 2 check

4th time- Lose all of recess- 3 checks

Other behavior modifications can include silent lunch.

Consequences continued

Positive behavior will be rewarded through the use of Positive Paws that will later be exchanged for prizes in the PHES prize cart.

Severe disruptions will be sent directly to the Principal's office

Parent's, please check School Status often. This will be the main form of communication and how we will communicate behavior issues.

Rewards

Our rewards include, but are not limited to, daily praise, success messages, Positive Paws, phone calls to parents, treats and other classroom incentives. Positive behavior will be rewarded through the use of Positive Paws that will ;later be exchanged for prized in the PHES prize cart.
