DRESS CODE POLICY

WIN ACADEMY DRESS CODE- will be enforced from the moment students enter the building each morning and will continue until the students exit the building for dismissal each afternoon.

PLEASE Read Carefully.

CLOTHING

• Shirt:

- SOLID GREEN, WHITE, OR YELLOW: Golf/tennis/ polo style shirt with a collar.
- Shirt must be long enough to be tucked in securely.
- A plain white undershirt (long or short sleeved) may be worn underneath.

PANTS:

- Full length khaki(tan) pants.
- Full length khaki(tan) jeans.
- Pants must be worn at the waist.

CLOTHING

- NO under garments are to be exposed at any time.
- Capris, cargo pants or any pants with pocket(s) on the legs are not allowed.
- GYM SHORTS- are not allowed underneath pants.
- SHOES: Athletic/ tennis shoes are RECOMMENDED, or fully closed dress shoes.
 - No boots are allowed



CLOTHING

- JACKETS: Coats or jackets must zip, button, snap from top to bottom.
- Pullovers and sweatshirts <u>are not</u> allowed.
- BELTS: <u>if worn NO</u> oversized or western buckles.
- Students may wear a <u>standard</u> wristwatch.
- Jewelry is not allowed.



Dress Code

Required Daily:

School Supplies will be provided.

NO book bags or back packs are allowed.

 Students should not bring anything with them to the WIN Academy campus.

DRESS CODE

 As per county policy, no items can be worn or brought to school that display pictures or imply information regarding drugs, alcohol, gang activity, weapons, or those of a sexually suggestive nature (as determined by the administration).



- 1. Participate in class every day.
- 2. Arrive at school prior to the start time (MS- 7:30 am, HS- 8 am)
- 3. Students who arrive to school late, <u>MUST</u> be signed in by a parent or guardian.
- 4. Appropriate behavior on the bus and at the home school is required.
- 5. Students begin check-in at 7:15 a. m. each morning.

Student Expectations

- 6. The school day ends at 2 p.m.
- 7. Students should be off campus no more than 15 minutes after the school day ends (2:15 pm).
- 8. No car dismissals will be made during bus dismissal.
- 9. **WIN ACADEMY** is **NOT** a bring your own device school. No electronic devices are allowed.

- 10. WIN Academy <u>must have three working</u> <u>phone numbers</u> on record.(Notify the school when information changes).
- 11. Textbooks are not issued, but may be checked out.

 See slide 32 for the school website to access online

 textbooks, or contact the teacher.
- 12. Payment must be made for damaged or lost text or Media Center books.

- 13. Students are to only use the office phone for emergencies (To be determined by staff).
- 14. All transportation arrangements should be made prior to coming to school, students do not call to remind parents of pick-up or appointments.
- 15. Infinite campus is always available for both parents and students.
- 16. Students are not allowed to bring outside beverages or food of any type into the building.

- 17. Students who do not ride a bus will be dismissed at the 2 p.m. final bell.
- 18. WIN Academy participates in **The Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)** program. (Please see pg. 20 of the student handbook) The program provides breakfast and lunch at no cost to all students.

- 19. Students under short term home suspension will be allowed to make up work upon returning to school. It is the responsibility of the student to coordinate with each teacher and turn in within (5) days of returning to school any make-up work.
- 20. Absence excuses should be placed through the slits on the top of the box outside room 401 or turned into the front office.

(within 3 days of returning to school)

Houston County WIN ACADEMY Attendance and Behavior Strategies

Attendance:

If a student misses 10% of their assigned time at the WIN Academy due to unexcused absences points will be assigned.

Behavior:

The number and severity of office referrals a student receives during their placement determines successful versus unsuccessful behavior. Points are assigned for both ISS and OSS.

If a student reaches the maximum number of points, the principal at WIN Academy will communicate with the home school principal to discuss the possible extension.

• The school's primary goal is to educate, not punish; however, when the behavior of an individual student comes in conflict with the rights of others, corrective actions may be necessary for the benefit of that individual and the school as a whole.

What is BULLYING...GEORGIA LAW

Definition of the Bullying Law:

- Any willful attempt or threat to inflict injury on another person, when accompanied by an apparent present ability to do so.
- Any intentional display of force that would give the victim reason to fear or expect immediate bodily harm.

Bullying

- Any intentional written, verbal, or physical act, which a reasonable person would perceive as being intended to threaten, harass, or intimidate.
- Causes another person substantial physical harm.
- Affects the student's education.
- Is so severe, persistent or pervasive that it creates an intimidating or threatening educational environment.
- Has the effect of substantially disrupting the orderly operation of the school.

WHAT IS SEXUAL HARASSMENT?

 Sexual Harassment of a student interferes with a student's right to receive an education free from discrimination.

 Sexual harassment is unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature.

SEXUAL HARASSMENT

SEXUAL harassment can be in the form of:

VERBAL HARASSMENT:

- comments made about a person's body.
- Spreading rumors that may be considered sexual.
- Sexual remarks or accusations.
- Telling 'dirty jokes' or stories when those who are listening are uncomfortable with what is being told.

...SEXUAL HARASSMENT

NON-VERBAL HARASSMENT:

- Displaying or distributing explicit drawings or pictures.
- Writing graffiti of a sexual nature.
- Sending crude or sexually descriptive emails or letters.
- Making obscene gestures.

Sexual Harassment

PHYSICAL HARASSMENT:

- Grabbing oneself or another student in a sexual manner that is unwanted, uncomfortable, embarrassing or offensive.
- Sexual assault

SEXUAL HARASSMENT

Reporting Bullying or Sexual Harassment:

Students may and should report Bullying/Sexual Harassment to the following persons:

- Parent/Guardian
- School Counselor
- Any School Personnel- teachers, paras, & office staff. All are mandated reporters
