A copy of the Summary Report of Title III Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives for 2006-2007 was distributed. Sanctions that occur after an LEA fails to achieve AMAO objectives for 2 and 4 consecutive years were discussed. Only AMAO #3 (AYP for the LEP subgroup) is being reported for the 2006-2007 school year due to issues with equating and scaling in the IPT by the test publisher, Ballard and Tighe. Randolph County did not achieve AMAO #3 for the 06-07 school year due to Grade 10 Reading.
