Parent Survey: The SCCSD is seeking the responses and input of parents/guardians and staff regarding your levels of comfort in a potential return to school. No official decisions have been made at this time regarding a traditional re-opening, but the district does solicit your views. Virtual Learning: All students who are currently engaged in virtual learning are strongly encouraged to turn cameras on for all lessons. This is helpful in determining attendance, as well as participation. Using an appropriate virtual background is recommended as well. Some students have attempted to give the appearance of being logged into class virtually, but are not there and are not participating. In these cases, students will be counted absent.

Bi-weekly Assessments: The Mississippi Department of Education has made it clear that students will take end-of-year assessments, no matter what. This means that whether students have learned virtually or whether they are using learning packets, <u>ALL</u> will be held accountable for learning. As a result, the SCCSD will resume its schedule for testing students bi-weekly, as well as its benchmark assessments. The first bi-weekly will be given to students during the week of October 12-16, 2020. Be on the lookout for specific schedules from your child's school. For students who are using learning packets, more information will be provided from the school on how bi-weekly assessments will be administered.

K-3 Universal Screener: Please be on the lookout for communication from your child's base school about taking their

universal screening test. Each child kindergarten through third grade must take their universal screening test by Friday, October 30th, 2020. This screening test will be administered at the school.

Progress Reports: All schools will be distributing progress reports this week. Grades are always available for review on ActiveParent; however, the progress reports will be available this week. Check with your child's school for dates and times for progress report distribution.
