School Census

The Board of Education shall conduct an annual census to determine the number of children of compulsory school age who reside in New Milford as of January 31 of each year. The enumeration of such children shall be conducted through the use of any reasonable means approved by the Commissioner of Education. The school district shall maintain a file of all children residing in New Milford under the age of 21, using the following classifications:

1. preschool;
2. attending public schools;
3. attending private or parochial schools;
4. attending post-secondary schools;
5. sixteen-or-over and not attending any schools.

In addition, the school district shall maintain a record of children who are of preschool age and older, up to and including children who will turn 21 during any regular school year, who are reported as having some disability that may require special education services, including non-resident students who are attending private or parochial schools located within the Town of New Milford.
