Goal #1: To Increase the number of students who have typical/high growth for CCRPI to at least the GA DOE State Target.

- Action 1: Increase the focus on literacy for all students.
- Action 2: Utilize differentiated instruction in all classes in order to meet students' learning needs.
- **Action 3:** Strengthen the current PLCs by providing direction and/or professional development on functioning as data teams.
- **Action 4:** Ensure that all CATs align their formative assessments with their summative assessments to enhance mastery.
- Action 5: Provide instructional toolbox to assist teachers with instructional strategies
- Action 6: Provide technological resources to assist in assessment and data collection for concept mastery.
- **Action 7**: Provide instructional tools/software to enhance instruction and concept mastery.
- Action 8: Maintain focus on school mission and vision.
- Action 9: Monitor student progress in classrooms.
- Action 10: Consistent professional development in content areas.
- Action 11: Pair new teacher with mentor teachers.
- Action 12: PBI Discipline Data Dig on student motivation for disciplinary issues.
- Action 13: Communicate grades and tutoring/enrichment activities every 3 weeks.
- Action 14: Celebrate student success through P.R.I.D.E. (PBIS).
- Action 15: Identify students who need additional remediation or enrichment to meet growth targets

Goal #2: To increase the graduation rate to at least the GA DOE State Target.

- **Action 1:** Identify students in danger of dropping out of school and provide targeted assistance, mentoring, and/or counseling.
- **Action 2:** Utilize test preparation software to strengthen student levels of mastery.
- Action 3: Incentivize students to succeed with celebrations each year for achievement, attendance, etc.
- Action 4: Communicate school mission and vision.
- **Action 5**: Continue professional learning for teachers and advisors.
- Action 6: Recruit for HCBE Job Fair.
- Action 7: Refine assessment cycle for CAT teams.
- Action 8: PBIS/Discipline Data Dig on student motivation for disciplinary issues.
- Action 9: Utilize parent contact log to ensure that parents are aware of missing student work and/or low grades.
- Action 10: Utilize the automated call-out system to inform parents of progress reports and major testing dates.
- **Action 11**: Monitor student attendance and notify parents when a student misses a significant number of school days.
- Action 12: Maintain school wide tutoring program.
- Action 13: Maintain Pride Time Response to Intervention.
- Action 14: Increase student feedback and investment
- Action 15: Assist students with college and career readiness for post-secondary options.
