KINDERGARTEN ART LESSON WEEK 2

In this lesson you will create a SNOWMAN! I know winter is almost over but we didn't get any snow! Which means, we didn't get to build any snowmen! Oh no! We are going to be practicing drawing LARGE and filling the paper with our snowman!

Supplies:

Two pieces of paper
Pencil
Sharpie
Markers or crayons or pastels
Paint (optional)
Scissors
Glue

If you don't have paint you can use anything you have on hand to create swirls! If you are not painting you can skip the first few minutes of the video because it is a painting tutorial for the kids! She also draws with a bingo dauber filled with black ink. If you do not have one draw with a pencil or a sharpie! There is some shading on the snowman added with a light blue chalk pastel you could use a crayon or sidewalk chalk!

-Create portraits (pictures of people) of your whole family AS SNOWMEN!
