Participants that successfully complete the criteria will receive a letter of recommendation signed by the Augusta Independent School District Superintendent and the Chairperson at TENCO. WORK ETHIC SEAL PROGRAM

Lighting a Torch for Success



The program purpose is to prepare students for the transition from school to work and life beyond the classroom. Students will develop a strong work ethic needed to secure and maintain successful and meaningful employment.

Augusta Independent School District and the TENCO Workforce Development Board have developed a specialized work program in which students who meet the required criteria related to work ethic and complete the Essential Workplace Skills Program will be awarded a Work Ethics Seal upon graduation.

We believe students receiving this recognition will have an advantage when seeking employment in our area and applying for college or technical school. Through the involvement and support from area businesses, the value of work ethics continues to be validated by employers who see the potential of a demonstrated work ethic credentialed candidate.

Augusta Independent Work Ethic Program Criteria

- Completion of Essential Workplace Skills Program
- Maintain at least 96% average daily attendance
- No more than three disciplinary referrals (9th—12th grade years)
- No course failures
- Be involved in at least 2 of the following:
 - *Organized sport
 - *Part-time employment (10 hours per week for 4 consecutive months during school or a minimum of 20 hours per week during the summer months)
 - *Extracurricular program (band, drama, school clubs, etc.)
 - *Verifiable school/community service project (Pre-approved by school administration)
- Present Work Ethic Exit Presentation to Committee
