Create a sketchbook with paper. Bind it with ribbon and a hole punch, twist ties, a stapler, etc.	Point out the copyright date of a book you're reading to someone at home and read for 30 minutes. Play it using the rhythms you have learned in music class.	Make a tasty treat with an adult
Pick a piece of fruit or a vegetable, sit it on a table, draw it to the best of your ability. Color it to look realistic.	Build a fort using blankets, pillows and couch cushions - read in it for 30 minutes!	Create & complete a "Career Family Tree" (careers for parents, aunts, uncles, siblings, grandparents)	Write a rap and perform it for someone at home. (Include some rhyming words to make it more catchy)	Create your own dance to your favorite song
Draw a portrait (picture of a person). It can be anyone in your house. It can look like a cartoon, realistic, abstract, etc. You decide. Add details like earrings, freckles, glasses, etc.	Write your own mini-mystery story! Don't make it too spooky ;)	Go to VaView.vt.edu; click on "Grade K-5 Kids" Click on "Kids Search" Explore five career clusters and complete a journal entry on your favorite one.	Watch 2 youtube videos that are posted under the "Music Listening" tab on Mrs. Eakin's website. (under "special areas" from your school's website) Identify the instruments you see.	Design your own board game or card game to play
Use what you have to create a 3-D piece of art. Ideas: a vase of flowers from a toilet paper tube and flowers from coffee filters) You decide!	Read a folk-tale or fairy tale.	Write a thank-you letter or card to a community helper.	Sing a song. Then write a journal entry of "What is your favorite song and why?"	Make a card to send to a family member
Draw something from a book. Do your best to make it look like that illustration.	Read a picture book to a younger sibling or a stuffed animal. What activity would you do that relates to the book?	Illustrate a "When I grow up" self-portrait showing what career you aspire to be when you grow up.	Write a journal entry of "What is your favorite style of music and why?" (Country, rap, hip hop, pop, alternative, etc.)	Build a tiny town using objects from your home (raid your recycling bin, use legos, etc.)
