CASE Benchmark Assessments are designed to gauge the academic progress of students and to provide timely feedback that can be used by teachers to guide instruction. The benchmark assessments, which are aligned to College- and Career-Ready Standards/Common Core State Standards (CCSS), & TNReady, provide valuable data regarding all students' knowledge of the standards. ACCESS for ELS	Feb. 16 – March 26, 2021	Students who are English learners. ACCESS for ELLs (ACCESS) is the collective name for WIDA's suite of summative English language proficiency assessments. ACCESS is taken annually by English language learners in Kindergarten through Grade 12 in WIDA Consortium member states.	Required	Fall 2021
AIMSWEB+	August 2020 January 2021 April 2021	Elementary school students are screened to determine qualification of RTI2 status using AIMSWEB+. Students who do not perform at grade level on their fall benchmark are tested for oral reading fluency and comprehension. Students are also assessed for math fluency.	Required	2 Weeks
I-READY	Fall/Winter/Spring	K-2nd grade students will be taking the iReady Diagnostic three times during the school year. The data from these assessments will be used to plan small group instruction and to develop an online course for each individual student based on his/her learning deficits. In addition, trends in the data will help to adjust our pacing for whole group instruction.	Required	1 Week
