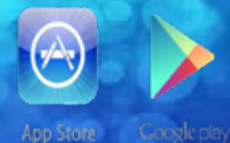

"It's a rare condition, in this day and age to read any good news on the newspaper page or news app. Love and tradition of the grand design, some people say it's even harder to find." - Do I believe I am a sinner and am I sorry for my sins?
- Do I earnestly intend with the help of God to amend my sinful life?
- Do I believe Christ's true body and blood to be present in the Lord's Supper for the forgiveness of sins?

If you are physically unable to come forward for Communion: Please let an usher know and the pastor will come to you and give you Communion.

Gluten Free - Ask an usher for a GLUTEN FREE PLEASE card when you attend communion. These are an easy and silent way to ask for a gluten free communion wafer.

Communion Wine: Non-alcoholic wine is available for Communion. It is located in the middle of the Communion tray and is gold in color.
