TOEFL and other Requirements

All international students must meet the freshmen or transfer criteria along with the TOEFL requirement (PBT: 550, IBT: 80). Students whose primary language is English may take the ACT or SAT in lieu of the TOEFL. Minimum scores for these tests are an 18 ACT/860 SAT
